Compilation	Final data book, manufacturer records book, job book	General term for a collection of cards that are submitted to the customer in a single file, usually as a PDF with a table of contents. Commonly refers to the final book submitted to the customer, but also refers to packages.
Package	-	Collection of related cards that are submitted to the customer as a single file (when it's component cards are NOT to be submitted to the customer individually). Used to manage documents like drawings and MTRs individually but submit as a package.
Expediting	Expedite request	Option to send reports of coming due/overdue document to customers, sub-suppliers, internally, or to other DocBoss users.
